

Annual MAC Carmichael Fund "MAC SIZED" BASS TOURNAMENT



Rules and Regulations

- 1. This is a two person per boat tournament.
- 2. Choose a partner or fish alone.
- 3. Winners will be determined by tournament officials based on a total weight of 5 (five) bass limit. Please request weigh in for all "BIG FISH"
- 4. Only spotted bass measuring 12 inches or more, large mouth measuring 15 inches or more, and small mouth measuring 18 inches or more will be weighed NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 5. Golden Rule will be the official board used.
- 6. Only artificial baits the meet Tennessee State Regulations are authorized. NO trolling.
- 7. No more than two contestants per boat.
- 8. Contestants may pre-register online at www.maccarmichaelfund.com on or before April 27, 2024 at 5pm for \$140.00USD per boat. Contestants can also register between 4:00am and 6:00am on the day of the tournament for \$150.00 per boat.
- 9. Golden Rule will be the official board used.
- 10. Live wells will be checked white exiting the NO WAKE zone. Please have both live well lids OPEN when you pass by the blast off boat.
- 11. There will be a one half pound (1/2 pound) penalty for ANY dead fish. ONLY one dead fish per boat will be accepted at weigh-in.

12. NO Alcoholic Beverages

- 13. Safe boating must be observed at ALL times. Each contestant is required to wear a fastened U.S. Coastguard-approved personal flotation device anytime the combustion engine is running from boat check until weigh in on the day of the tournament. All boats must be equipped with an emergency ignition-shutoff device that must be securely attached to the driver's body when the combustion engine is running. All persons must be seated, and the driver must be behind the steering wheel in full control of the boat whenever it is on plane or the combustion engine is running and in gear.
- 14. Insurance: Liability insurance with coverage in reasonable amounts is required of all boat-owner contestants.
- 15. To receive points for participating in the tournament as a Tennessee BASS Nation member, both ANGLER and CO-ANGLER must be member of a Tennessee BALL Nation Club and it must be noted on your registration form prior to blast-off the morning of the tournament.
- 16. Boater chips must be in the bucket by 3:00pm on day of tournament. If the tournament participation requires "weigh in flights", the boater and partner will be notified at blast-off of their weigh-in/check in time.
- 17. Prizes to be awarded:

\$3000 guaranteed 1st place

\$500 Big Large Mouth Bass Guarantee

\$250 Largest Kentucky Spot/Spotted Bass Guarantee

\$500 Largest Small Mouth Bass Guarantee

\$100 Smallest Legal 15" Bass Guarantee

ONE (1) place per 10 boaters will be awarded. (For example, with 70 boats registered, 7 places will be awarded. With 71 boats registered, 8 places will be awarded.)
